A greenbelt of native species is being developed, total 51826 Nos. of saplings have been planted including Gap filling in place of perished sapling covering in an area of 16.81 ha. inside the mining lease area. In addition to above, 26000 nos. of saplings have been planted outside road covering 25KM side areas of the mining lease area The density of existing plantation is around 2500 plants per ha.

2 LAND RECLAMATION

Top soil shall be stacked properly with proper slope with adequate safeguards and shall be back filled for reclamation and rehabilitation of mined out area.

At present top soil generation is nil. However, topsoil generated in future will be stacked separately and will be utilized for plantation purpose.

3 WASTE MANAGEMENT

Over burden shall be stacked at earmarked dump site(s) only and shall not be kept active for long period. The maximum height of the dump shall not exceed 20 mt. each stage shall preferably be of 10 m and over all slope of the dump shall not exceed 28°. The mine pit area shall be reclaimed by back filling the OB in a phased manner. The OB dumps shall be scientifically vegetated with suitable native species to prevent erosion and surface run off. Monitoring and management of rehabilitated areas shall continue until the vegetation becomes self-sustaining. Compliance status shall be submitted to the Ministry of Environment & Forests on six monthly bases.

### PPs Submission: Being Complied

The Over Burden (OB) generated during mining operation is being dumped at earmarked dump site and phase-wise stabilization of OB dump is under process. Plantation of native species have been carried out in inactive terraces of OB Dumps.

Garland drains shall be constructed to arrest silt and sediment flows from soil and mineral dumps. The water so collected shall be utilized for watering the mine area, roads, green belt development etc. The drains shall be regularly de-silted particularly after monsoon and maintained properly. Garland drains (size, gradient and length ) shall be constructed for both mine pit and for waste

dump and sump capacity shall be designed keeping 50% safety margin over and above peak sudden rainfall (based on 50 years data ) and maximum discharge in the area adjoining the mine site. Sump capacity shall also provide adequate retention period to allow proper settling of silt material. Sedimentation pits shall be constructed at corners of the garland drains and de-silted at regular intervals.
